

The SECUMAX PLASTICUT is different from the other products in our range but only in the detail. But you know: that's what often matters most. This flexible disposable cutter is best used for thin film and paper. Due to its width of just 2.5 mm, cutting protective film stretched over a thin gully as between door and pillar on a new car is also possible. The blade is made of stainless steel, the cutting edge is TiN coated. And: the SECUMAX PLASTICUT is perforated - in case you want to add additional fittings later on.

No blade change

Nose for piercing

You will not put away the SECUMAX PLASTICUT so easily. That's because it is comfortable, light and handy. It has a

slightly raised and pointed nose and is therefore ideal for piercing into the material to be cut.

Stainless steel blade

Not all film cutters are fitted with a stainless steel blade. The SECUMAX PLASTICUT is an exception. What's more: even its cutting edge is TiN coated. Both increase the value and durability of your cutting tool.


Protected goods.

The quality blade is safely embedded between the nose and the handle. So it only cuts what you really want to cut. And there is no risk to your goods while doing so.

To protect your fingers

The perforation in the handle has a very specific purpose: You can attach an additional finger protection bracket here. The hand that is cutting will then be able to grip better. Better safe than sorry.

To reduce the danger of injuries, hold the hand that is being used to restrain and stabilise the cutting base in such a manner that the restraining hand or even other body parts are not endangered in the event that the knife slips. Do not modify this product in any way. Modifi-

cations of any kind may impair product safety. CAUTION: The risk of injury caused by manipulation of this product is extremely high. When both cutting edges are no longer sharp, dispose of the knife as general waste.

3. Non-use of the knife: Store the knife in a secure place.

4. Care instructions: Always keep the knife clean and do not expose it to unnecessary humidity to safeguard a long service life.
